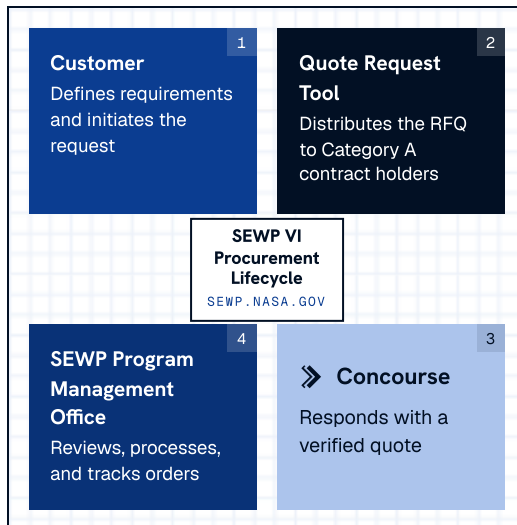

SEWP VI Contract Overview

Scope: The NASA Solutions for Enterprise-Wide Procurement (SEWP) VI Government-Wide Acquisition Contract (GWAC) can be used by all U.S. federal agencies — civilian and defense — and authorized government contractors. Category A covers information technology, communications, and audio-visual products, plus product-based services, including software and software subscriptions.

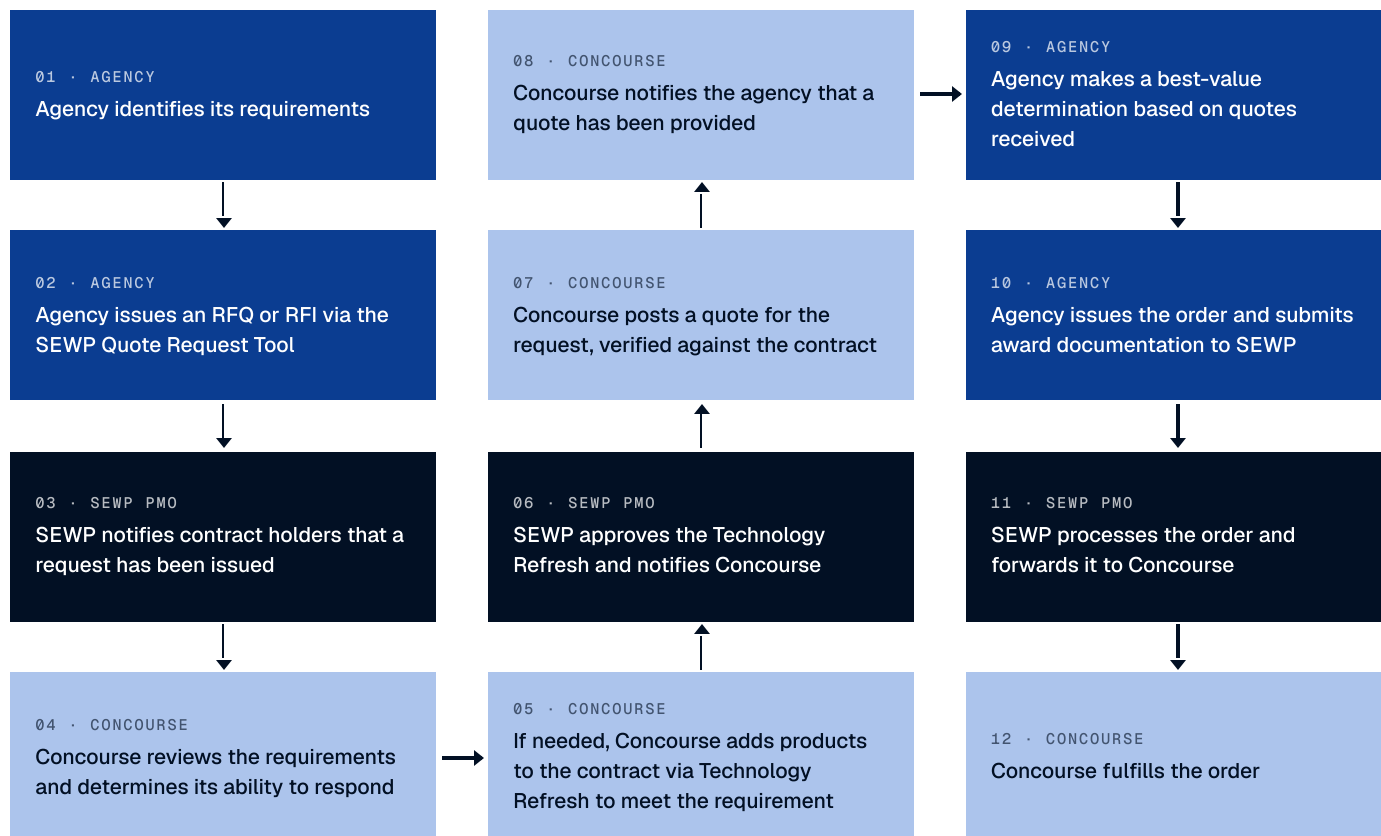
ORDERING PROCESS

How to Order From SEWP VI

In the typical SEWP ordering process, the agency defines a requirement and issues a Request for Quote through the SEWP online Quote Request Tool, which distributes it to all contract holders in the selected group. Contract holders respond with verified quotes; the agency makes a best-value determination and issues a delivery order through its own contracting office. The SEWP Program Management Office reviews, processes, and forwards issued orders to the contract holder — typically in under one business day.
